Rock-Solid Study Habits

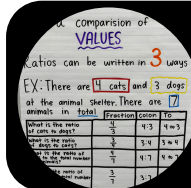

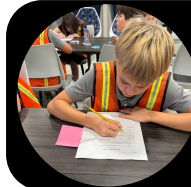
To support learning across all grade levels, we displayed math anchor charts transforming our ASC into a visual construction zone filled with tools for success — from formulas to problem-solving strategies.
