Wallace Gregg Elementary School staff will:

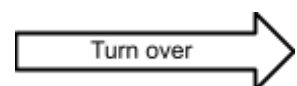
1. Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the children to meet the State's student academic achievement standards as follows:
