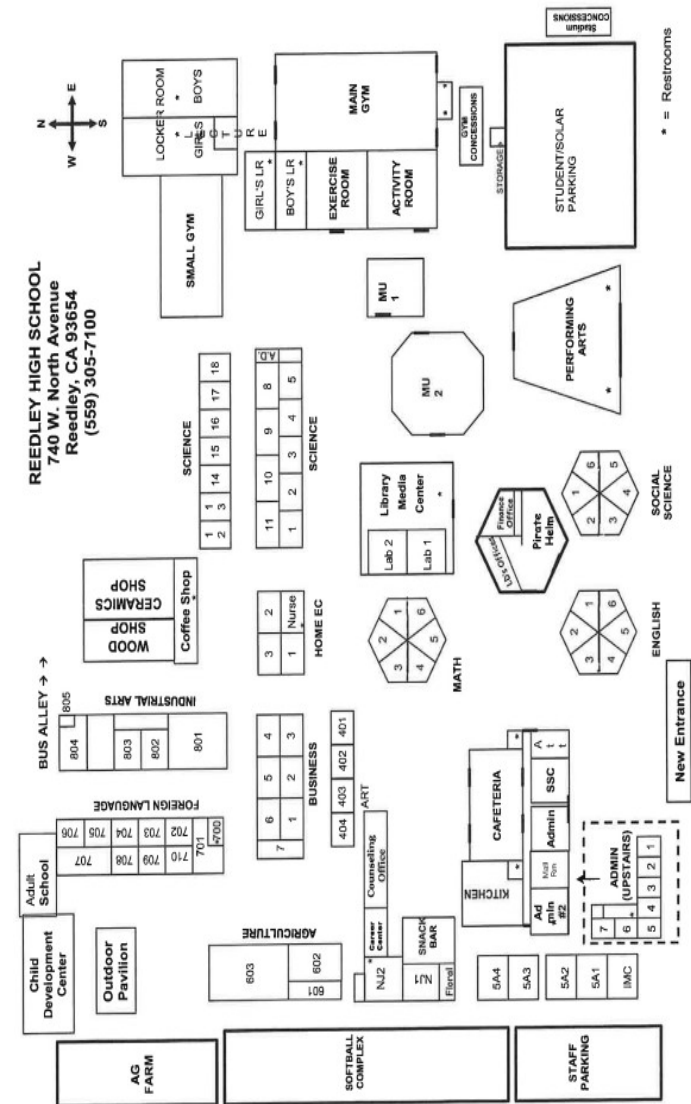

CNA COURSE

HOW DO I QUALIFY FOR THE COURSE?

- Must pass a basic math and English pre-entrance test with 70% or better
- Must have valid CA drivers license or ID and Social Security Card or I-TIN.

Course Requirements and Expectations:

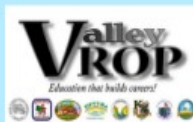
Prepare yourself to work in the Medical Field

ADMISSION

All adults 18 years of age and over may register for classes regardless of residence.

There is no tuition cost or registration fee to enroll in adult school.

Small fees may apply to vocational training classes.

All Kings Canyon Adult School students enrolling in the ABE, ASE, and ESL programs are required to test prior to placement and upon completion of their semester.
