Forsyth County Schools Achieve Top Milestones Rankings in Georgia

Cumming, Ga. – Forsyth County Schools (FCS) demonstrates academic excellence, earning some of the highest Georgia Milestones scores in the state for the 2024–25 school year.

FCS ranked first among large districts (over 1,000 students tested) in math End of Grade (EOG) assessments for all elementary and middle school grade levels. At the high school level, students earned the highest End of Course (EOC) scores in American Literature, Algebra, and Biology for large systems. In English Language Arts (ELA), 7th grade students earned the highest score in the state among large systems, and all elementary and middle school grades ranked within the top three large systems statewide for ELA. Multiple schools also placed within the top 20 in Georgia for both EOG and EOC assessments.

Superintendent Mitch Young said these results are a testament to the dedication and hard work happening in classrooms every day. “We are extremely proud of our students, teachers, and staff for achieving some of the highest Milestones scores in the state,” he said. “While we celebrate these outstanding results, we will not be complacent. Our commitment to continuous improvement means we will keep challenging ourselves to ensure all students reach their highest potential.”
