
Sobrato Theater Society Performance

While not sensationalized or dramatized, it offers a thoughtful recounting of the events leading up to and surrounding the tragedy, culminating in how the community began its journey through grief, healing, and renewal in the aftermath. *Warning*: This show contains discussion of mental illness, school shootings, death, and child loss.

Fall Finals Exam Schedule 2025

Finals are around the corner! Finals can be a large portion of Fall semester grades, ensuring that students study and are present for them are a key to their success. Academic Focus Week (December 8-12)

The week before finals is referred to as Academic Focus Week. This week is dedicated to preparing students for their semester exams. Although teachers may introduce new

material the week should be predominantly used as review. Contrary to popular belief among students, homework during Academic Focus Week is permitted and appropriate.

MINGA

Sobrato is transitioning to a fully digital hall pass system. This means that students will no longer receive paper passes from the front office. All passes (late arrival, bathroom, nurse's, and early dismissal) will appear on MiNGA. Students can access MiNGA using a cellphone or a chromebook.

When families are aware their student will be leaving early on a certain day they will contact the attendance office as soon as possible, preferably before lunch time. Once we receive their call/voicemail, a MiNGA pass will be created. The pass will instantly appear on the student's MiNGA profile. Passes are visible when students click on the bell notification on their MiNGA app. The student can show the pass to their teacher when their time to leave approaches on their chromebook, or when they enter the classroom on their phone before they hang it in the caddy.

Our new process will ensure class time will not be interrupted to call a student's classroom to send them to the office to leave school. Thank you for your cooperation.
