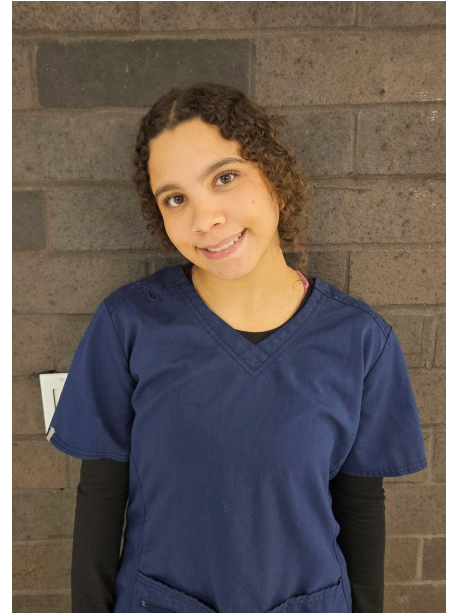


October Student of the Month: TALIAH CHAVIES
