Be on the look out for phone calls and emails from teachers and staff



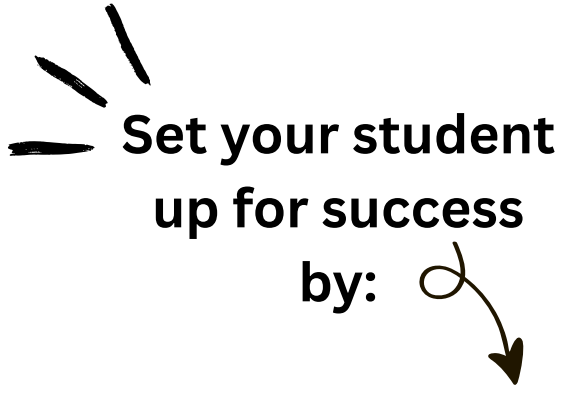
Class Dojo
