

When in-person learning cannot take place because of inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances, students will learn at home. The State allows a limited number of eLearning days during the school year and unlimited Remote Learning days.

We will use Remote Learning Days after all state-given eLearning Days have been used. We will announce which type of learning our schools are on via ParentSquare, TV, Radio and Social Media.

01. REMOTE LEARNING

- Remote learning days run on a **delayed schedule**, which means school starts at
 - 9:20 a.m. for middle, intermediate and high schools
 - 9:20 a.m. (AM Class) for Amp Lab and Career Academy
 - 9:30 a.m. for elementary and early childhood
 - 11:30 a.m. (PM Class) for Amp Lab and Career Academy
- **Synchronous instruction** is learning that takes place live on student devices with their teachers over Zoom.
- Zoom links and resources are available on your teacher's Schoology page.



02. STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- Students should engage in live, virtual instruction according to the schedule posted by their teacher(s).
- Attendance is taken live by teachers for each class period.



03. PARENT EXPECTATIONS

- Parents should ensure their child has an appropriate learning environment that is a quiet place, free of distractions to participate in live Zoom sessions.
- Parents should ensure their child is logging on to Schoology daily to access assignments.
