WHEREAS, the reauthorization of *ESEA* in December 2015 by the *Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA)* expanded and clarified how federal funds received under the law may be used; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Annual School Planning Process consolidates multiple needs-assessment processes into one coherent system; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Annual School Planning Process serves as a framework for long-term, sustained improvement that is considered best practice, and, therefore, is available for all New Jersey schools; and

WHEREAS, a schoolwide program is a comprehensive reform strategy designed to upgrade the entire educational program in a Title I school with a poverty percentage at or above 40 percent or in a Title I school with a poverty percentage below 40 percent that was granted an eligibility waiver exception by the state educational agency; and

WHEREAS, operating a schoolwide program should result in an ongoing effort to bolster the academic achievement of the entire school community while tailoring reform strategies and interventions to meet the unique needs of all students, staff, and families; and

WHEREAS, all eleven elementary schools and the Bayonne Alternative High School have completed their Annual School Plans, with stakeholder input; and

WHEREAS, the Annual School Plans will be available on each school's website; and

BE IT RESOLVED that the following eleven Annual School Plans and the Bayonne Alternative High School plans be accepted for the 2025-2026 school year.
