PICK-UP/DROP-OFF REMINDERS

Families are reminded that dropping off at the cross walk or across the street is not allowed. It is extremely important for families to not drop off students in the street for their own safety. It is important even more so now that our roads have become icy and slick with snow. If you are dropping your student off after school begins, families must come in to the front office to sign in

their student for the day. Please help us be respectful and courteous of our neighbors, and keep our students safe!

Also as a reminder, we cannot call students down prior to your arrival if you are picking them up early from school. Families are welcome to park in the bus lane as long as it is not within 30 minutes of start or dismissal of school. We do not release students for early pick-up after 2:15, so please plan accordingly.



Our Picture Retake/Class Picture Day is coming up next week on Tuesday November 18th! All students that were absent on the original picture day need to be photographed for school records, so please encourage your student to dress their best for picture day. If you would like to purchase portrait packages online and did not get the chance to last time, families can go to <https://accessmyevent.com/GH2390>. Please do not fill out an order envelope if you purchase portrait packages online. You may also fill out a paper order form instead.

For families needing retakes, the original portrait package MUST BE RETURNED and families need to include a note on what they would like different about the photo. (*i.e.*, "hair down", "shirt buttoned", *etc.*) Please note: retake portraits will be the same package, options, and background style as the originals. Retakes requesting an upgraded option or different background are subject to a 40% reprint fee of the original package price.

For class group photos, all orders must be submitted using a separate ordering envelope. Online ordering for class groups will not be available.
