Students have an opportunity to explore new endeavors in a safe, supportive environment while having loads of fun! They will remain in the same classroom space for the full day with the same students.

Fees:

Full Day - \$475 per week + materials fee

(Session 3 is a 4-day week; tuition is prorated to \$380.)

Early Birds (7:30-8:30 AM) - \$55 per week

Milk & Cookies (3:00-5:30 PM) - \$125 per week

Insurance (optional) - \$50 per camp

* There will be a 3% fee added to credit card purchases.

Registration:

Once you have completed your online registration, you will receive a confirmation via email that your order was received. You will have the option to pay for camp in full or pay a \$75 non-refundable deposit per camp. If you need to make changes to your camp order, see the policy on the Stanley British Primary School website.

The full balance of tuition is due by April 1. If a credit card was used for the deposit, and we have not received an alternate form of payment prior to April 1, we will charge the balance to that card. After April 1, there are no refunds issued (unless we cancel camp).

You also have the option to buy insurance, which is \$50 per camp. If you choose to withdraw for any reason and have purchased insurance, you will be refunded 100% of your tuition. If Stanley must cancel camp for any reason, you will be refunded your tuition.
