



## **Inclement Weather Dismissal Procedures**

FSUS Families, please be patient during these times of severe weather dismissal. Safety is our number one priority, and the process may be delayed due to the number of students being dismissed one by one.

### **Rainy Day Dismissal:**

- Students are dismissed as normal.

### **Severe Weather Dismissal (Lightning):**

- An intercom announcement will inform teachers to hold all students in classrooms.
- All EDEP students will be released to **EDEP**.
- An intercom announcement will be made to release all athletes and extracurricular activities to their designated locations.
- An intercom announcement will be made to release all **Bus and Van** riders to the car loop.
- An intercom announcement will inform **student drivers** to go to your vehicle and immediately exit campus.
- Student drivers with siblings will be released and report to the cafeteria stage. Drivers will request their siblings to be released to the cafeteria. Drivers with elementary siblings will need to provide their car tag.
- Front office staff will begin calling secondary student names over the intercom.
- Intercom announcement will be made for students to be released and proceed to car loop at Administration's discretion.

### **Severe weather while in Car Loop:**

If severe weather occurs while students are in the car loop:

- Elementary report to the cafeteria.
- 6-12 students will report to the gym.
- Follow the steps outlined above

### **Severe weather shutting down school.**

If severe weather occurs and is cause for the school to be closed:

- Parents will be notified via FOCUS messaging.
- Students will remain in classrooms.
- Administrators will be in the car loop and will call into classrooms from the cell phones.
- Raptor Reunification procedures will be used in the front loop. FSUS staff will verify parent/guardian in FOCUS and ID while student is in route to the front of the school.
