This letter is to inform you about the upcoming winter Keystone Exam testing window at River Valley High School. The Keystone Exams are Pennsylvania's statewide end-of-course assessments designed to measure student proficiency in Algebra I, Literature, and Biology. Under this regulation, students must demonstrate proficiency, defined as earning a score of 1500 or higher, on each of the three Keystone Exams in order to meet statewide graduation requirements (Act 158).

Our records indicate that your child did not yet achieve a proficient score and/or has not taken a required Keystone exam and will need to take the corresponding exam(s) during the upcoming winter testing window.

Algebra Keystone	December 9 th & 10 th
Literature Keystone	January 5 th & 6 th
Biology Keystone	January 7 th & 8 th

We encourage you to discuss the importance of these assessments with your child and remind them to put forth their best effort. Performing well on the Keystone Exams not only fulfills a state graduation requirement but also reflects your child's mastery of key academic skills necessary for future success.

Testing Logistics for River Valley Cyber Academy Students:

All River Valley Cyber Academy students are expected to test in-person on their scheduled testing day(s). After completing their exam, students may either remain in the cyber lab for the remainder of the school day or be picked up in the main office once testing concludes.
