The course will also help you to develop an understanding of external influences such as:

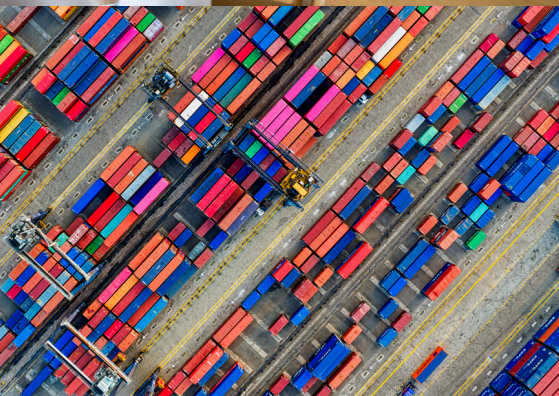
- economics;

## SKILLS

- Commercial awareness - gaining insight into how markets operate, how businesses compete, and how global events influence decision-making.
- Ethical reasoning - considering the impact of business decisions on stakeholders, society and the environment.

Your progress will be assessed through a mix of written exams and case study analysis, with a strong focus on applying business theory to real-world situations.

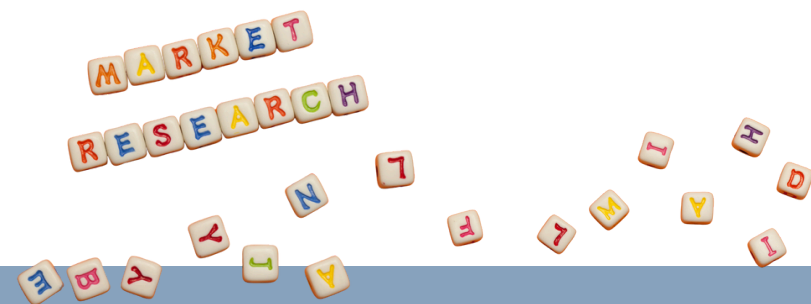
