Invitation to Bid

November 12, 2025

The Blount County Board of Education is accepting written sealed bids for materials, equipment, and labor for the installation of an LED Videoboard with scoreboard software for Locust Fork High School Football Stadium in Locust Fork, Al.

Scope of Work

1. Bidder to provide all materials, labor, and equipment required for the installation of an LED Videoboard with scoreboard software with a screen size of 18' X 30'.
2. Bidder to provide engineered drawings for the installation of the structure to support the LED Videoboard and install according to these specifications in the site plan.
3. Bidder to provide all materials and installation of power supply from existing service on site and based on inspection and agreement with the owner and utility provider.
4. Bidder to provide all materials and installation of control lines, data lines, or fiber as required for complete operation. All control or data lines to be run to the existing home side press box and connections provided for controllers, computers, or iPad equipment necessary for the operation of the videoboard.
5. Bidder to provide the necessary controller, computer, MacBook, or iPad for the operation of the videoboard.

Product and Services

1. LED module and Cabinet Minimum Specifications:
 - A. Pixel Pitch 6-8 mm
 - B. UL listed or OSHA-approved equivalents
 - C. 100% Aluminum backing and aluminum framed cabinet
 - D. Viewing Angle 140-160 Horizontal/110-120 Vertical
 - E. Refresh Rate 7600 Hz or higher
 - F. Gray Scale 14-16 bit
 - G. Brightness 8,000 to 10,000 nit
2. Scoreboard software must be compatible with Daktronics, All American, Fair Play, Electromech, OES scoreboard controllers.

3. LED Videoboard controllers should have the capability to connect with camera systems for providing live feed from the game, crowd, etc.
4. LED Videoboard controllers should have the software capability to play videos and have a graphics package for TD's, 1st downs, etc. and for displaying advertisements.
5. LED Videoboard controllers should be compatible with the current sound system to synchronize the video and the sound.
6. LED Videoboard controller should be able to run maintenance patterns and diagnostics.
7. Bidder to provide on-site training, controllers, and pre-loaded content package for complete operation of the system.

Conditions

1. The bidder shall provide all necessary software, wiring (power, control, and data), power supplies, modules, connections, supporting accessories and final commissioning.
2. Bidder must provide a site plan that includes proposed equipment locations and engineered drawings of the structure to support the Videoboard.
3. All wiring shall be installed in appropriately sized conduit.
4. No wiring shall be run overhead.
5. All work must be performed by qualified and licensed personnel.
6. All work must be performed in a manner that meets or exceeds the current applicable electrical, mechanical, structural and life safety codes.
7. Electrical work will be inspected by the owner's Master Electrician.
8. The contractor shall provide up to three hours of orientation and training on the operation of the system.
9. The BCBOE reserves the right to make changes and requirements at any time to the invitation to bid prior to bid date and on the day of open bid, pertaining to specific manufacturing specs and size of the LED Videoboard.
10. The final award to successful bidder will be made based on the best advantage to the BCBOE.

Warranty Repair Service

Installing contractor shall warrant all labor, equipment, and structure for a minimum of one year following the project completion date. Equipment warranty beyond one year will be based on the manufacturer's standard warranty. Successful bidder should have the capability of providing warranty parts and service for the videoboard.

Bidding Instructions

1. Vendors must use the attached form for submitting bids. **Faxed or emailed proposals will not be accepted.**
2. Non-resident bidders must accompany any written bid documents with a written opinion of an attorney at law licensed to practice law in such non-resident bidder's state of domicile, as to the preferences, if any or none, granted by the law of that state to its own business entities whose principal places are in that state in the letting of any or all public contracts and bid awards.
3. Bids may be submitted in any of the following ways in an envelope clearly marked **LED Video Board for Locust Fork High School Bid**:

4. Bidder must have a General Contractor's License for Alabama, be insured and must be enrolled in E-Verify. A copy of the contractor's license, certificate of insurance and E-Verify documentation must be included in the bid envelope.
5. Said sealed bids will be received until 9:00 A.M. on Wednesday, December 3, 2025, at which time said bids will be opened publicly at the Blount County Board of Education located at 415 5th Avenue East, Oneonta, Al 35121. Bids should be submitted in an envelope plainly marked "**LED Videoboard for Locust Fork High School**". The Board of Education reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
