
New Jersey Student Learning Assessment for English Language Arts (NJSLA-ELA), Mathematics (NJSLA-M), and Science (NJSLA-S)



- Participation is required by federal and state law for all students in grades 3-8 and high school to ensure they have access to a high-quality education.
- Measures how well students meet the New Jersey Student Learning Standards (NJSLS).
- Identifies areas of curricular strength along with opportunities for improvement in each of the tested content areas.
- This presentation compares results of NJSLA 2023, NJSLA 2024 and NJSLA 2025.



NJSLA Spring 2023, 2024, 2025 English Language Arts/Literacy – Percentages








2025 NJSLA ELA: Race/Ethnicity



Percent Meeting or Exceeding Expectations






2025 NJSLA ELA: Subgroups










2025 NJSLA Math: Race/Ethnicity




Percent Meeting or Exceeding Expectations







Percent Proficient or Advanced Proficient






2025 NJSLA Science: Subgroups

Notable Achievements



English Language Arts

- Students across all grade levels are at or above all Reading standards.
- Students in Grades 6-9 have shown improvement by both decreasing numbers in levels 1 & 2 and increasing numbers in levels 4 & 5
- More ML students are meeting expectations

Mathematics

- At the elementary level, our African American and Hispanic students have increased their numbers this year in levels 4 & 5 by 12% and 16% respectively.
- At the secondary level, our students are achieving above the state average for grades 6, 7, Algebra 1, Geometry and Algebra 2

Science

- At each of the tested grade levels we have increased the percentage of students who are proficient or advanced proficient each year
- In 2025, the percent of students who met the proficiency level increased at 9 of the 12 elementary schools.





Intervention Strategies



English Language Arts

- At the elementary level, we continue targeted interventions through Amplify CKLA & mClass.
- At the secondary level, we are utilizing our literacy coach both to help with daily instructional strategies and to support writing standards

Mathematics

- At all levels, we are working to differentiate instruction, so students meet and exceed standards, providing Tier 1 & 2 supports as needed.
- At the secondary level, we are infusing the curricula with items from the released question bank, so students gain familiarity with the format.

Science

- At the elementary level, we continue to foster vertical articulation and integration of ELA standards/practices in science journals
- At the secondary level, we continue to update benchmarks, chunk skills by band and expand OpenSciEd programs.
