



# COMMUNITY COLLEGE CLASS OPTIONS

## FOR GHC STUDENTS

GHC students can earn college credit while still in high school through dual enrollment and/or concurrent enrollment. Both are college-level courses that are open to all GHC students, but **there are some key differences:**

### DUAL ENROLLMENT

Dual enrollment courses count for both high school and college credit. The program is exclusively for GHC students.

- Courses only offered in the fall and spring.
- Take courses with other GHC students.
- Tuition, fees, and books are covered.
- GHC dual enrollment counselors will enroll students.
- All courses will earn high school credit.
- K-12 forms are sent to the designated dual enrollment counselor.

### CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

Concurrent enrollment courses can earn college credit, may also earn high school credit, and are open to the public.

- Courses offered in the fall, spring, winter, and summer.
- Take courses with other community college students.
- Tuition is free, but GHC students are responsible for additional fees.
- Students will enroll themselves during their registration appointment via LACCD portal.
- Not all courses will earn for high school credit.
- K-12 forms are sent to the student's school counselor.
