5.0 JUNIOR BULLDOGS

- Junior Bulldogs begin by sharing a few photos from their recent

camps and events. They introduce a few new staff members as well. They continue by sharing the financial reports from their summer camps. The camps all had great participation and each student who attended received a shirt. Jr. Bulldogs are now preparing for their winter sport camps, specifically basketball and wrestling. They are also participating in the upcoming Trunk or Treat event. Lastly, they are in the process of contacting coaches and verifying teams through the Greeley Rec Center.

6.0 STAFF REPORTS

6.1 Principal's Update - Jeff Casey

- Jeff starts his presentation by letting Ryan Wehrman share about the student participation in each of the fall sports/activities. University has a large number of students involved in extracurricular activities. The marching band is preparing for their upcoming State Championship Competition. Cheer and Dance are preparing for their upcoming seasons. E-Sports is up and running and they're doing really well so far. Speech and Debate is preparing for their season as well. Softball is ranked #2 and will be hosting a regional tournament. Cross Country is competing against some tough schools and are getting ready for their state qualifier. Boys tennis started their regional competition and they have a couple of athletes posed well to go to the state competition. Football is ranked 9th and has a shot at making it to the state tournament. Volleyball is ranked in the top 10 and will be hosting a regional tournament as well. Ryan continues by sharing a few special moments that happened this season at some of the JV and C team levels. There will be a few changes coming up regarding classifications. Population and enrollment have dictated classifications in the past, and different sports have different enrollment standards. Now, they are trying to get back to consistent numbers allowing each of the teams to play in the same classification. Ryan will be sending out some

questionnaires to see the interest in sports like soccer, golf and girls flag football.

- Jeff continues by sharing about Aims Concurrent Enrollment and how much student involvement University has. He also shares about AP participation, students who take classes at UNC, and our consistently high graduation rate. High school departments have PLC's which are groups of teachers working on specific projects and solving specific problems.

- Superintendent Weaver starts by giving a few updates from the auditorium and cafeteria projects. We have been working on finding flooring options for the new cafeteria addition. We are also looking for student information tools to help with our dismissal procedures. One of the best options is from Raptor, which we already use as a part of our security systems. The EPIC system has been really beneficial in both day to day classroom activities and our security drills. Homecoming was a big success and there was a lot of student participation at each of the events. We had a great turnout from distinguished alumni as well. Conferences and the recent play also went really well. Jennifer thanks all of the people for working hard on the Weld Trust Grant and celebrates how well the Smartlab has been doing this year. The middle school has had a lot of student participation in all of their fall activities as well. There is a band concert currently going on and they've been working really hard. Cross country finished their season and finished 3rd and 4th in last week's league meet. 8th grade volleyball is currently competing in their regional competition. The volleyball team was also the most academically accomplished group in the middle school. 7th and 8th grade football is doing well and they are hosting their championship game soon.
