## SCHOOL & COMMUNITY

Riverwood International Charter School, one of sixteen high schools in the Fulton County School System, opened in the Fall of 1971. It is accredited by the Georgia Department of Education, Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, and the International Baccalaureate Organization. Riverwood International Charter School is a four-year academic, college/career preparatory high school that offers various programs, services and experiences aimed at addressing the interpersonal, social, physical, and academic needs of its students.

The Mission of Riverwood International Charter School is to prepare students to be confident, creative, compassionate global citizens through high expectations for learning, excellence in teaching, seamless curriculum, community service participation, and engagement of parents and community. The vision is to deliver a challenging curriculum that gives all students the tools needed to be successful contributing members of our nation and the world.

Riverwood is a comprehensive high school and the site of Fulton County's only International Studies Magnet Program, which focuses on increasing students' capacity in both Social Studies and World Language. Riverwood is the only Fulton County school offering both the International Baccalaureate Diploma and Middle Years Programs. This prestigious college prep institution prides itself on having a diverse, talented student and faculty body. One of the unique features of this school, is that students who graduate from Riverwood go on to a wide array of colleges and universities. In addition, our students are regularly awarded Georgia HOPE Scholarships and rank among the highest achievers in the nation on the SAT and ACT. In Fall of 2019, Riverwood opened a new, 112,000 square foot, state of the art school building.


