LITERACY GRANT

As we announced last spring, our district was awarded with a \$1.13Million grant to support literacy over the next four years. So far we have been able to initiate Science of Reading training for all staff, which will be ongoing. In addition, we have hired Lindsey Franklin as our district Literacy Coach who has been hard at work helping administer the grant, set up training, and provide coaching to teachers, among other things. Jodi Hershberger is now an Early Literacy Paraprofessional, concentrating on providing literacy interventions to K-2 students. We will soon be planning a Family Literacy Night to be held in January. We will be communicating more about this amazing opportunity as the year progresses.
