 - ii. Fun Run
 1. Thank you to the entire committee for a wonderful and successful event!
 2. We exceeded our school wide goal of \$20,000 by raising \$20,947 between online and in-school donations, plus additional money from shout-outs, parents running, and 2 additional donations to the event from the CARE Company. We add on to this the fees that were covered from online donations, for a total of \$22,636.
 3. Top class was Mrs. Clemence's class and they earned a Zoyo party.
 4. There were 20 superstar students.
 5. The highest class per grade earned \$50 in extra recess equipment.
 6. The Fun Run committee was given a budget of \$2,000 but

we spent less than \$50 on t-shirts since we found so many great local companies to donate money. I added the t-shirt expense to the fun run committee expense line item below.

7. The Fun Run committee was given a budget of \$1,500 to spend on other expenses for putting on the fun run. Right now we are on track to spend under \$1,200 when all is complete. This includes:
 - a. Around \$200 for the event itself. This included the keychain prizes for registering, and supplies used the day of.
 - b. Around \$400 on the assembly, with the majority of this being spent on donuts, which is a special treat for all the kids for achieving the \$20,000 goal.
 - c. Around \$100 on the superstar lunch and winning class Zoyo party.
 - d. Around \$500 on prizes for top class per grade and Scholastic gift cards for top 3 earning students. These include: Mrs. Ambrozy, Mrs. Ateek, Mrs. Silverman, Mrs. Clemence, Mrs. Phillips, and Ms. Gerding
