Additionally, at the High School, we have replaced our old Lockers, which are now larger to accommodate our students' coats and belongings.

We will also continue to develop and grow our Fine Arts programs (music and art) at both the Elementary and High School levels. Last year, we witnessed a full-scale drama production at the High School, as well as the development of two Art Clubs at both the High School and the Elementary School. Last but not least, starting next school year, Lordstown Schools will use FinalForms exclusively as the district's official forms.
