#### **PSAT**

The PSAT will be given at Northeast Dubois on Wednesday, October 8<sup>th</sup>. The PSAT can prepare you for the spring school accountability exam, prepare you for all college entrance exams, qualify you for academic and career-tech dual credit opportunities, and possibly help you qualify for scholarships. Retests will not be required by the state if you meet that competency another way. This mandated SAT in the spring is free and will count for college admission.
