Celebrations:

Update on priorities/ goals

Goals: Every student grows academically every year in English Language Arts, Reading, Math, Science, and Social Studies.

Monitoring Goal: Title I funds will be used to hire non-employee tutors for small group intervention to support at-risk students so they may meet the challenging state academic standards.

- Title 1 funds: Tutors- second tutor pending, AR: Pending
- Fundraiser \$13,030: How should we spend our money? Suggestions provided to the committee.

Pumpkin Day was just under \$800. The items that were bought were purchased with the thought of future opportunities for students. (ex. Wheel barrels, big connect four). Mrs. Mendiola, our parent lighthouse member, stated that it was a great experience and loved the opportunity to volunteer on campus. Parents appreciated that they could choose the time they were available and had clear direction on what they were doing to volunteer.

Feedback

- **Academics Action Team: Goal A Campus!**

Academics Action Team:

We have a strong MTSS process! We have invited our special education care team to the most recent meeting for true collaboration with our student check-ins.

Teacher Growth data: Unit/Module assessment and celebrations!

We also had a data meeting in PLC's to review tracking student by growth measure that is impacting how students track their personal leadership portfolios.

There have been many impact stories of students and staff recognizing the next steps in their personal data journey. We are excited to have every student working on building a leadership portfolio. This process takes time and we want to continue to value the learning involved with portfolios.

Culture Action Team:

MRA Survey feedback on Family Events

2024: No truck or treat, no Shacktacular due to low attendance. We are going to continue with family events like our Dec 3-5 Fall event: 'Leaders Learning Everyday Parent Style' is tied to the classroom. We will continue to survey our families for feedback. The culture committee will partner with the leadership team for a day time family event.

Leadership Action:

-Oct. 27 Campus Walks - Feedback: Teachers did walks in each other

-Leaders Learning Everyday: It is a morning meeting, follow their student from the time they get here at arrival to also participate in morning meeting. Mrs. Newsom shared the vision, how this will look for families and ideas for EBA's portion of this family event.

-Lighthouse Certification: 15 teachers submitted for this certification. Mrs. Newsom explained how we will be finalizing and highlighting those classrooms who submitted for certification. District representatives will be coming to campus to walk these classrooms and engage with student ambassadors to help prep our students for sharing our Shackelford greatness.

Mrs. Northcutt parenting sessions for family engagement are set and we are excited to partner with families to learn the 7 habits.
