

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AP, AICE, and IB at a Glance

- In the 2024-2025 school year (SY), 14,816 students completed 28,942 AP exams (2 tests per student), 18,237 students completed 39,068 AICE exams (2.1 tests per student), and 270 students completed 848 Higher Level (HL) and Standard Level (SL) IB exams (3.1 tests per student).
- There was an increase of 2,053 AP exams, 5,331 AICE exams in SY 2025 and 117 HL and SL IB exams compared to SY 2024.
- **In SY 2025, SBBC students passed AP exams and HL and SL IB exams at higher rates than in the SY 2024 (AP=5.6% Increase and IB=9.9% Increase).**
- **100% of students who completed the Theory of Knowledge IB exam passed.**
- Comparing passing rates of the three largest racial/ethnic groups, White students outperformed their peers on AP and AICE exams. Hispanic students outperformed their peers on IB exams.

SUBJECT: **ADVANCED PLACEMENT PROGRAM, ADVANCED INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION, AND INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE DIPLOMA PROGRAMME ENROLLMENT AND RESULTS, SY 2024-2025**

This memo and the attached appendices summarize student participation and scores from the Advanced Placement Program (AP), Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE), and the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme offered during the 2023-2024 school year.

The AP program provides high school students with the opportunity to experience college-level coursework and demonstrate mastery of subject-specific content through national examinations. AP exams are scored on a scale of 1 to 5, and many colleges and universities will award course credit for scores of 3 or higher.¹

The Cambridge AICE Diploma is an international curriculum and examination system that emphasizes the value of broad and balanced study. Alongside an in-depth understanding of a variety of subjects, students also need to master a wider range of skills critical for success in university study and employment. AICE exams are scored on an eight-point scale, and many colleges and universities will award course credit for scores of 3 or higher.²

The IB Diploma Programme is an international curriculum and examination system that aims to provide a challenging and comprehensive education that enables students to understand and manage the complexities of their world and to develop the skills and attitudes for taking

responsible action in the future. The IB curriculum prioritizes skills in writing, critical thinking, creativity, and community service. Students are taught via a teaching model that emphasizes inquiry, reflection, and action. Courses culminate in an exam graded on a seven-point scale, and some colleges and universities award course credit for scores of 4 or higher.³

AP, AICE, and IB 2 Year Overview

- Broward high school students completed more AP, AICE, and IB exams in the 2024-2025 school year than in the 2023-2024 school year.
- Students passed AP and IB exams at a higher rate in the 2024-2025 school year compared to the 2023-2024 school year.

ADVANCED PLACEMENT PROGRAM

Student Participation Rates, Overall and by Race/Ethnicity

- 20.6% of Broward high school students participated in the AP program and completed 28,942 exams in the 2024-2025 school year.
- 12th-grade students participated in AP courses at a higher rate than other grade levels.

- AP students completed, on average, two AP exams in 2024-2025.
- On average, Asian (2.6) students completed more tests than White (2.1), Hispanic (1.9), and Black (1.6) students.

Scores and Passing Rates by Race/Ethnicity

- Student participants passed AP exams at a rate of 71.3%.
- Asian student participants (81.2%) passed AP exams at a higher rate than students of other races.
- White student participants outperformed Hispanic and Black student participants by 4.8% and 24.3%, respectively.

ADVANCED INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION (AICE)

Student Participation Rates, Overall and by Race/Ethnicity

- 24.7% of Broward high school students participated in the AICE program and completed 39,068 exams in the 2024-2025 school year.
- Tenth-grade students participated in AICE courses at a higher rate than other grade levels.

- AICE participants completed an average of 2.1 exams in 2024-2025. Hispanic participants completed more exams (15,888) than students of other races.
- There was little variability across races in the average number of exams completed (0.4).

Scores and Passing Rates by Race/Ethnicity

- Student participants passed AICE exams at a rate of 71%.
- Asian participants (80.8%) passed AICE exams at a higher rate than students of other races and ethnicities, followed by white students (76.3%) and Hispanic students (74.9%).
- White student participants outperformed Hispanic and Black students by 1.4% and 13.6%, respectively.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB) DIPLOMA PROGRAMME

Student Participation Rates, Overall and by Race/Ethnicity

- Broward high school students participated in the IB program and completed 848 Higher Level (HL) and Standard Level (SL) Exams and 127 Theory of Knowledge (TK) Exams in the 2024-2025 school year.
- Tenth-grade students participated in IB courses at a higher rate than other grade levels. Exams are administered only for 11th and 12th-grade students; however, participation in the IB Diploma Programme can begin in ninth grade.

Scores and Passing Rates by Race/Ethnicity

- Student participants passed HL and SL IB exams at a rate of 64.6%.
- Black student participants (220) passed the most HL and SL IB exams compared to their peers of other races.
- Multi-race participants (84%) passed the HL and SL IB exams at a higher rate than students of other races and ethnicities, followed by Hispanic students (78.3%).
- Hispanic student participants outperformed White and Black students by 8.6% and 24.9%, respectively.
- 100% of Broward students who completed the TK exam scored a D or higher and passed, which is a requirement to earn the IB diploma.
