RE: Parent's Right to Know

As a parent of a student attending Grand Mesa Middle School, you have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers who instruct your child. This is a requirement for all districts that receive Title I funds. Federal law also allows you to request certain information about your student's classroom teacher and requires the district to provide this information in a timely manner upon such a request. Listed below is the information about which you have the right to ask for regarding your child's classroom teachers.

- Whether the Colorado Department of Education (CDE) has licensed or endorsed your student's teacher for the grade level and subject matter taught.
- Whether CDE has decided that your student's teacher can teach in a classroom without being licensed or qualified under state regulations because of special circumstances.
- The teacher's college major, whether the teacher has any advanced degrees and, if so, the subject area of those degrees.
- Whether any teachers' aides or similar para-educators provide services to your child and, if so, their qualifications.
