

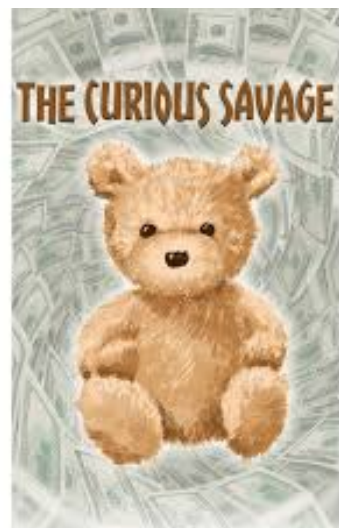

## 2025-26 SAT, PSAT Info



CV will host the SATs on the following dates:

- Nov. 8 (*registration deadline has passed*)
- Dec. 6 (registration deadline: Nov 21)
- March 14 (registration deadline: Feb. 27)
- May 2 (registration deadline: Apr. 17)

Students create an account, register, and pay at [collegeboard.org](https://collegeboard.org). Doors open at 7:30 a.m. and the exam begins at 8 a.m.

## Calendar Reminder



This fall, the District revamped its elementary progress reports to now accurately reflect each student's individualized educational journey throughout elementary school!

This week, we're focusing on what families should know as they prepare for **family-teacher conferences** later this month. Every teacher is expected to have a hard copy of the progress report to send home with families at Family-Teacher Conferences later this month. Teachers will walk families through the new progress reports during Family-Teacher Conferences. There will be evidence of your student's performance - including artifacts and work samples from the classroom.

We prioritize two-way communication at conferences so families/guardians should bring questions and concerns. If your student works with other teachers (ex: ESL, special education, intervention/enrichment), families may meet and discuss progress with these teachers, as well.
