ENROLLMENT HONORS SEAL or ENROLLMENT HONORS PLUS SEAL

Indiana's Enrollment Seals are designed to help students meet the minimum admission requirements for state universities. The Enrollment Seals emphasize academic preparedness and ensure that students are equipped with the necessary qualifications to succeed in a post-secondary educational environment.

ENROLLMENT HONORS SEAL

- Earn a C or higher in all courses and earn a cumulative B average, **and**
- Complete one of the following:
 - Earn 4 credits in AP courses and take corresponding exams
 - Earn 6 college credits
 - Earn 3 college credits and 2 AP credits and take corresponding exams
 - Score a 1250 on the SAT or a 26 on the ACT

ENROLLMENT HONORS PLUS SEAL

Earn the Honors Enrollment Seal, plus:

- Earn a credential of value: AP Scholar with Distinction or Indiana College Core, **and**
- Complete at least 75 hours of work-based learning, **and**
- Demonstrate skill development in Communication, Collaboration, and Work Ethic
