New Trimester Information

Trimester 2 started on Monday at Lincoln Academy. Report cards for trimester 1 were sent home in Monday folders for students in grades 1-4. Students in grades 5-8 can see their final trimester grades in Infinite Campus.

Now is a great time to review your student's **Emergency Contacts** in Infinite Campus. These contacts are who we call in the event we are unable to reach parents/guardians. They are also the people authorized to pick up your student at the end of the day. Please see this <u>Jeffco Help article</u> on how to review and update, if needed, your Emergency Contacts. Any changes will not automatically be visible; the update takes a few days.



Traffic Reminders

This is also a good time to go over the traffic rules for campus. These rules are designed to keep our students and staff safe, so please respect and obey these rules:

- The North Lot is for parking and walking with your student, not a Driveline drop off or pick up spot.
- The North Lot is a one-way, counter clockwise traffic pattern.
- Students should not be entering or exiting vehicles anywhere in the Driveline loop except at the front sidewalk.
- If you are not coming on campus, do not drop off or pick up on Oak St. The side street of Parfet St is the safest location.
- The speed limit on campus is 10 miles per hour.
- No smoking or dogs on campus.
- No phones while in Driveline.



How Sick is too Sick?

As we enter cold and flu season, it's important to remember the guidelines Jeffco, and Lincoln Academy, follows to ensure a safe and healthy environment for all of our students, staff and families.

There are four main reasons for children and adults to stay home:

- 1. The child or staff member could infect others with a contagious illness, either because of symptoms, a diagnosis or recent exposure to a contagious illness.
- 2. The child or staff member does not feel well enough to take part in usual activities. For example, a child is overly tired, fussy or will not stop crying.
- 3. A child needs more care than teachers and staff can give while still caring for the other children.
- 4. The child or staff member has symptoms or an illness on the <u>CDPHE public</u> <u>guidance document</u>, and staying home is required.



Food Support

As a school and a district, we believe **no child should go hungry**, and we are actively coordinating with Jeffco and their community response called **Jeffco Feeds Jeffco** to ensure every student and family has access to the resources they need.

Area Construction Update



Road Construction Update from the City of Arvada

The City of Arvada Oak Street sewer line replacement project will have northbound lane closure on Oak from W 69th Ave to Owens beginning as soon as the week of November 24th. Work will begin on a side street along W 69th Place & Newman before moving to Oak for approximately six weeks.

- Northbound Oak St. detour on W. 69th Ave. to Owens
- Southbound Oak St. will remain open
- Alternating one-way traffic during work on side streets (W 69th Pl., Newman, W 69th Ave.)
- Approximately six weeks on Oak, 2-3 months total

Construction schedules are weather-dependent and subject to change. More details at arvadaco.gov/624. Please plan for extended travel times. As always, help keep crews and travelers safe; please use caution near the work zone.
