

Description


The diagram below illustrates how schools in St. Mary's County Public Schools currently matriculate from one grade level to the next. Lines connecting each school circle represent the next school in sequence in a student's educational career as read from left to right.

- Feeder splits are based upon attendance boundaries and the way they overlap from one grade level to the next.
- 5 out of 18 elementary schools have their enrollments split between all four middle schools.
- 3 out of 4 middle schools have their enrollments split between all three high schools.





- Chesapeake students are not included in counts.
- Counts only include students residing within St. Mary's County Public Schools boundary.
- Special education PK students are not included in counts.
- Utilization goals are based on students residing with St. Mary's County Public Schools boundary.
- Number of students affected compares where students are enrolled to where they would be assigned.
- Only permanent capacity is used in calculations. Portable capacity is not included.
- Subdivisions (neighborhoods) are not split and kept intact and are as defined by County data.
- Utilization goals are based upon existing conditions or conditions created by a specific scenario such as repurposing of a school.
- Elementary school options are paired with middle school options unless otherwise noted. This is so that students move from elementary school into middle school together and are not split into separate schools. For example, elementary school option 1 and middle school option 1 are a set and cannot be mixed and matched with other elementary and middle options.
- High school options are independent of any other option and stand on their own.

Guidelines

The following lists planning guidelines used when developing possible attendance boundary options. These guidelines were used when and if to the extent possible.

- Students should not cross major roadways or intersections.
- Minimize travel distance.
- Minimize disruption to existing boundaries.
