## Staff Spotlight Award Recipient

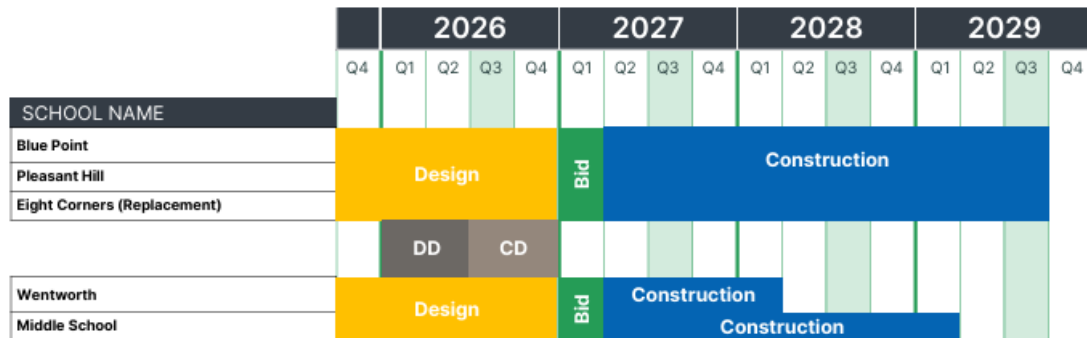

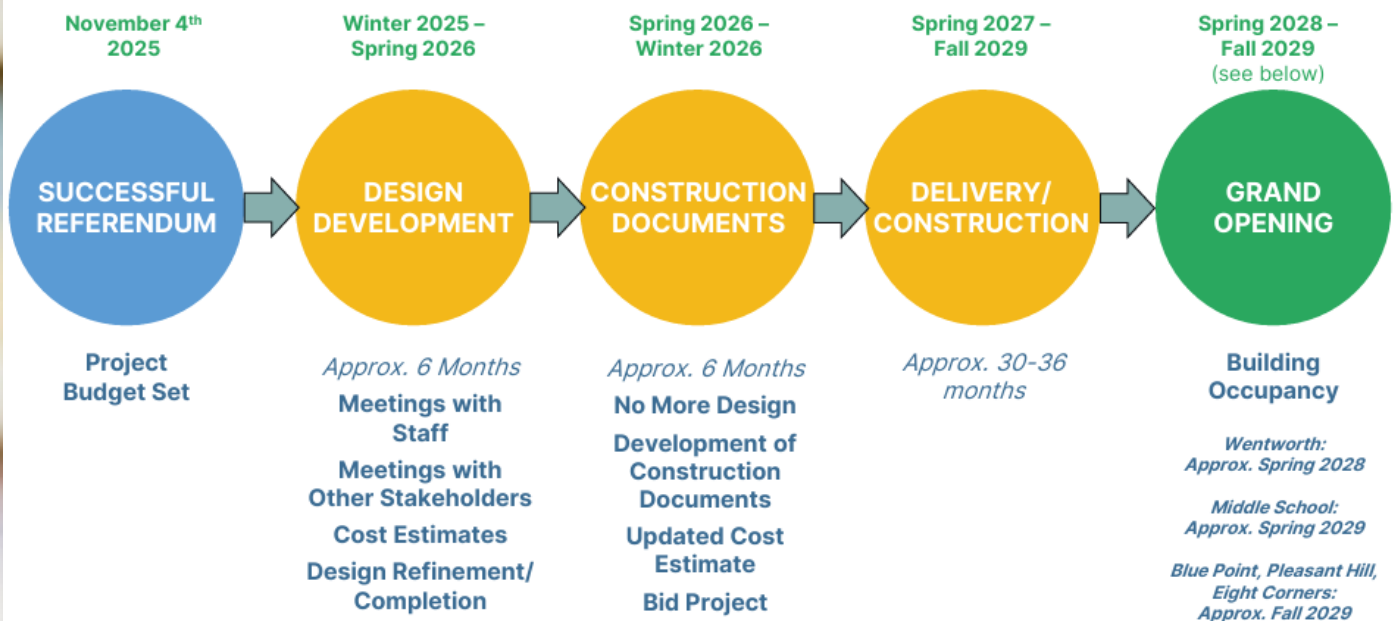

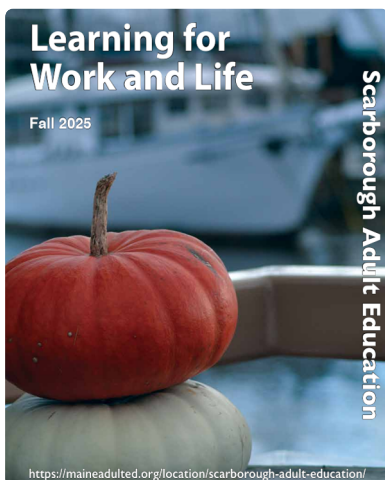
