SCHOLARSHIP TIPS

Essays are the key to success for many scholarships. Be sure that you read the prompt carefully and answer the prompt. Each student is unique, so it is important to tell your story. You should avoid clichés like "I want to make the world a better place." Make sure you proofread your essays for typos and grammatical errors. Try reading your essay aloud to your parents to catch mistakes.

Many scholarships require letters of recommendations. If you have already asked teachers to write letters of recommendation for your college applications, ask the same teachers to edit your recommendation letter for scholarships.
