Bounce!	Albee	Follow the scientific history of rubber including who discovered it, where it came from, and how it is made. Back matter includes a timeline and a note about the social and environmental problems with producing rubber.
Dogtown	Applegate	When Chance, a real dog, and Metal Head, a robot dog, break out of the Dogtown shelter, they embark on an adventure to find their fur-ever homes, encountering both danger and unexpected kindness along the way.
Fast and the Furriest, The	Behrens	The overweight and unathletic son of a famous former football star discovers that his equally fat and lazy dog is unexpectedly--and obsessively--interested in competing in dog agility contests.
Fear Place, The	Naylor	When he and his older brother Gordon are left camping alone in the Rocky Mountains, twelve-year-old Doug faces his fear of heights and his feelings about Gordon--with the help of a cougar.
Ferris	DiCamillo	During the summer before fifth grade, Ferris Wilkey has her hands full with her little sister terrorizing the town, her Aunt Shirley moving into their basement and her grandmother seeing a ghost--one who has wild, impractical and illuminating plans.
Firefly Summer, The	Matson	When her estranged grandparents invite her to stay with them in the Poconos for the summer, Ryanna meets many relatives on her late mom's side of the family and discovers a whole new side of herself--and a place where she really belongs.
First State of Being, The	Kelly	When Ridge, a time-traveling teenager from the future, gets trapped in 1999, he befriends Michael, a lonely twelve-year-old boy, changing the course of their lives forever.

Frindle Files, The	Clements	Together with his best friend Vanessa, and using all the computer skills they've got, Josh is determined to solve the mystery of their teacher's past in this follow-up to the classic book <i>Frindle</i> .
Good Different	Kuyatt	Selah Godfrey knows that to be "normal" she has to keep her feelings tightly controlled when people are around, but after hitting a fellow student, she needs to figure out just what makes her different--and why that is ok.
Great Zoodini, The	Gardner	When his latest escape goes wrong, the Great Zoodini--a fennec fox--winds up at an animal sanctuary/drive-in movie theater where he gets the chance to become world-famous but wonders if fame is worth losing his newfound family--the only ones who've ever accepted him.
How to Catch a Polar Bear	DeKeyser	While working at his uncle's custard stand at the zoo in 1948 Milwaukee, Nick discovers his summer won't be so boring after all when he must solve a mystery involving a polar bear while stopping his uncle's competitor from playing dirty.
Lasagna Means I Love You	O'Shaughnessy	When foster kid Mo finds a handmade cookbook filled with someone else's family recipes, she collects the stories behind them and builds a website to share them, secretly hoping a long-lost relative will find her and give her a family recipe all her own.
Legend of Greyhallow, The	Short	Ainsley Galloway and her brother, Tobin, accidentally open a passage between their new town and a magical realm reminiscent of the popular Greyhallow movies and must close the portal to save their new home.
Legend of the Last Library, The	Cole	In a dystopian world where paper is scarce, Juni finds a book that reveals the location of a hidden library and faces threats from a powerful corporation determined to control it.
Liars Society, The	Gerber	When the money for their school trip is stolen at their elite Boston School, Weatherby and Jack, each protecting secrets that could destroy their lives, are invited to solve this high-stakes mystery, which would guarantee their entrance into the oldest, most powerful society in the world.
Light and Air	Wendell	In the 1930s, Halle and her mother are diagnosed with TB and sent to a hospital in upstate New York where she discovers joy, family and friendship, until a setback throws their entire future into question.

Takeout, The	Badua	When a new restaurant opens near her dad's Filipino Indian food truck serving the exact same foods, Mila dabbles in Filipino folk healing and magical traditions to expose them for the recipe thieves they are.
Thing About Georgie, The	Graff	Georgie's dwarfism causes problems, but he could always rely on his parents, his best friend, and classmate Jeanie the Meanie's teasing, until a surprising announcement, a new boy in school, and a class project shake things up.
Trouble at the Tangerine	McDunn	Simon is ready to make the Tangerine Pines his forever home, but when a robbery occurs in the apartment building, he and his new friend set out to solve the case and keep his family from moving again.
When Life Gives You O.J.	Perl	Zelly wants a dog more than anything, so at the urging of her grandfather, she takes care of a "practice dog" made out of an orange juice jug to show her parents that she is ready for the responsibility, even though she is sometimes not entirely sure about the idea.
