<p>STUDENT CHARGES (BORROWING/GRACE PERIOD) Students may charge meals up to the value of two breakfasts and two lunches (\$9.50 for Junior High). An automated phone call occurs when a negative balance appears on a student's account. If a student account exhausts the grace period/charge limit, the student must select a peanut butter and jelly or toasted cheese sandwich entree for lunch and/or a cereal entrée for breakfast until the negative balance is paid. A la Carte items are <u>not</u> available for charging.</p>				
<p>FREE/REDUCED-PRICE MEAL PROGRAM We encourage you to complete the USDA free/reduced price meal application if you feel economic hardship exists. Applications expire each year and must be submitted each year. Applications can be submitted online at www.schoolcafe.com or through the SchoolCafe app on your mobile device to determine if you qualify for benefits. Hardcopy applications may be found at the school's front office, if needed, or at the Child Nutrition office located at 1110 Baker Dr. Tomball, TX 77375. Eligibility decisions are based on federally established income and household size guidelines without regard to race, sex, color, national origin, age, or disability.</p>
