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Special Affidavit of a Resident Providing Housing for a Family with School Age Children

This is a legal document which must be sworn to and signed in the presence of a notary public. The Board of Education will use this affidavit to determine whether the student is entitled to a free education in this school district. Every question must be answered or the Affidavit will NOT be considered. You bear the burden to provide proof sufficient to establish the existence of a family in your residence.

Special affidavit children are those children who with their parents are being housed in Audubon (K-12), Audubon Park (K-12) or Mount Ephraim (9-12) and want to attend Audubon Public Schools. Such children and their parent(s) must be kept in the home of a person who is domiciled within the Audubon Public School district (ie Audubon, Audubon Park or Mount Ephraim). Such person shall be referred to as “responsible resident” in this document.

An affidavit must be filed on an **ANNUAL BASIS** prior to the start of each school year by the responsible resident with the Registrar of Audubon Public Schools indicating that he/she is domicile within the district and is providing housing for the child(ren) and his/her parent(s) and intends to provide said housing for the school term. This is in accordance with New Jersey statutes 18A:38-1.

Under NJSA 18A:38-1(c), any person who fraudulently allows a child of another person to use his/her residence for entry in the local public school system and is not the primary financial supporter of that child commits a disorderly persons offense and is liable to a maximum jail term of six (6) months and to a maximum fine of \$500 or both. Further, under NJSA 18A: 38-1(b), any person who allows a child of another person to use his residence for entry into the local public school system where such a child is not entitled by law to a free public education in the local public school system will be liable for tuition to the local public school district.

I have read the above information concerning the residency in the Audubon Public School district and understand I will be held liable for any information falsely reported on this affidavit.
