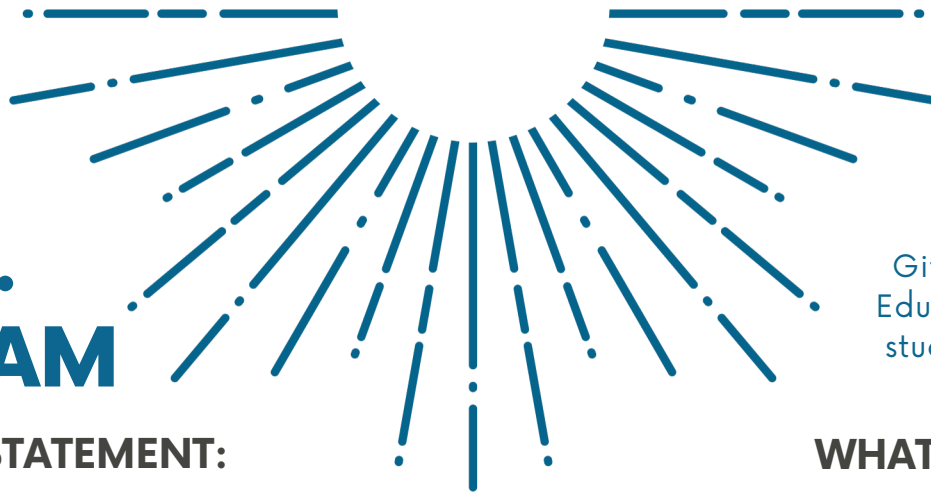

Encourage deep inquiry skills to stimulate and encourage creative problem solving.

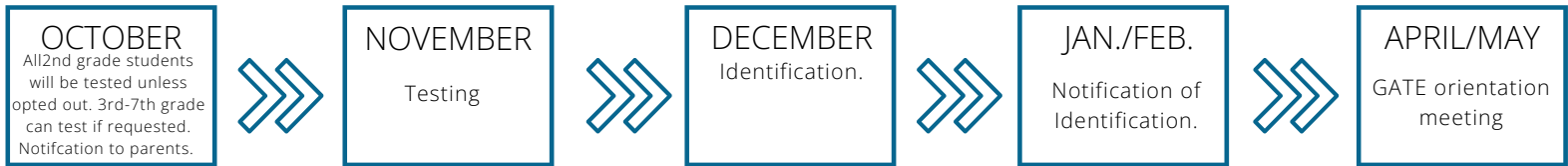


Build awareness of choices and develop realistic understanding about personal abilities.

Self-Contained GATE classes for students grades 3-5.

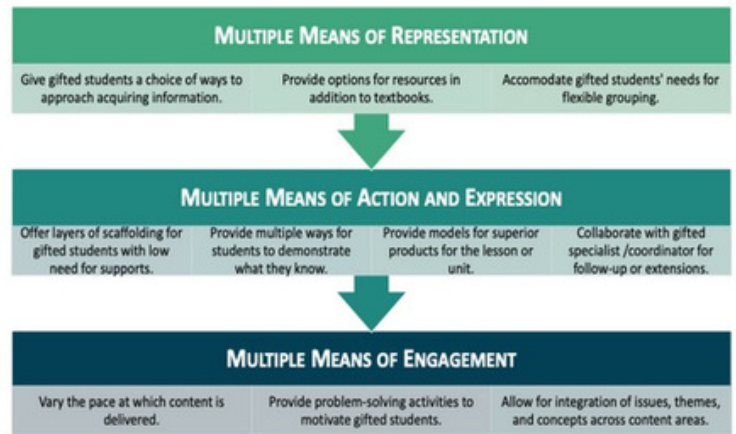


GATE clusters where students grades 3-5 receive differentiated small group enrichment and instruction.
