Goals

For the 2025-2026 school year:

Hospital Homebound will increase academic support to all HHB K-12 students by integrating more technology into their meetings with students.

Paulding College and Career Academy will increase enrollment and retention of students as evidenced by increased enrollment numbers, placements in internships and apprenticeships, and increased success on EOPAs.

Paulding Virtual Academy will improve student learning outcomes in EOC courses by implementing a progress monitoring process that identifies individual student needs, informs instructional decisions, and supports timely interventions.

Phoenix program will 1) Improve student engagement among virtual learners and attendance in the live sessions, and 2) Audit student transcripts and develop an individualized graduation plan to give students the opportunity to graduate with their cohort.
