The Superintendent of Schools presented a short video highlighting the which provides Glen Cove High School students with second year of the Junior Volunteer Program at Glen Cove Hospital, the opportunity to volunteer and gain firsthand experience in the medical field.

The video, created by Ms. Victoria Curtis, showcased the valuable experiences and contributions of participating students. Following the presentation, each student was invited to the podium to receive a certificate of recognition, and a group photo was taken to commemorate the occasion.

Dr. Doeschner continued her report by announcing that the district was featured in the season opener of Spotlight on Long Island, a radio program now in its ninth season. The Superintendent of Schools shared that several district administrators, teachers, students, and Board of Education members participated in the broadcast. They were proud to highlight the district's accomplishments, including the successful passage of the bond—made possible through strong community support—which allowed for the renovation of all science labs in the high school's science wing.

Additionally, Dr. Doeschner noted that Glen Cove High School was ranked among the top 40% of the best high schools in the nation, and Finley Middle School was recognized among the top 40% of middle schools in New York State, both reflecting the district's continued commitment to academic excellence.

She continued her report with displaying pictures of the open school nights at both Finley Middle School and the High School that she attended.
