## Hoosac Valley Middle Annual School-Family Compact 2025-26

*The school – family compact is a written agreement that outlines how families, the school staff, and students will share the responsibility for improved student academic achievement and develop a partnership to help children achieve the State's high standards.*

The **Hoosac Valley Middle School** will:

- Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables middle school students to meet the State's student academic achievement standards.
- Hold parent/guardian-teacher conferences annually during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement.
- Provide families with frequent progress reports on their children's progress. An individual student report to each family/guardian about the performance of their student on the State assessment in at least mathematics and English language arts/reading will be provided.
- Provide families reasonable access to staff. Specifically, staff will be available for consultation with families via email, phone, or conferences. Information to families/guardians will be in an understandable and uniform format, including alternative formats, upon the request of families/guardians with disabilities, and, to the extent practicable, in a language families/guardians can understand.
- Timely notice to each family/guardian when their student has been assigned or has been taught for four (4) or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who has not met state licensure requirements.
- Provide families opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities. Opportunities for regular meetings for families/guardians to formulate suggestions and to participate, as appropriate, in decisions about the education of their students
- The school will inform families/guardians of the school's participation in Title I and the requirements of Title I, including family engagement requirements.

As the **teacher**, I believe all students can learn and I will;

- Create a safe and respectful learning environment,
- Respect and value each child and their family,
- Sustain positive relationships with families and seek ways to involve them in their student's learning,
- Maintain open lines of communication.
