

- Do you lack a permanent physical address?
- Do you live at a temporary address?

If you answer **YES** to any one of the these questions, *let the social worker at your child's school know*

## YOUR CHILD GETS:

- ✓ to immediately enroll in school.
- ✓ to continue at the same school if transportation is feasible.
- ✓ to attend special programs and after school activities.
- ✓ to receive transportation to conferences or school events.
- ✓ to automatically qualify for free lunch at school.
- ✓ to have free school supplies.
- ✓ to receive needed services just as all other students do.

If you live in one of these situations, you do **NOT** need to provide:

- Proof of residency
- Immunization records
- Birth certificates
- Previous school records for your child to enroll in or attend school

The McKinney Vento Act is a **guarantee** that you can enroll in and attend school **if you live...**

In a shelter (family shelter, domestic violence shelter, youth shelter or temporary housing program)

In a motel, hotel or weekly rate housing

Doubled up with friends or relatives because you cannot find or afford housing

In an abandoned building, other inadequate housing accommodations or in a car

On the street

With friends or family because you are an unaccompanied youth
