Enjoy fun, games, and Santa!

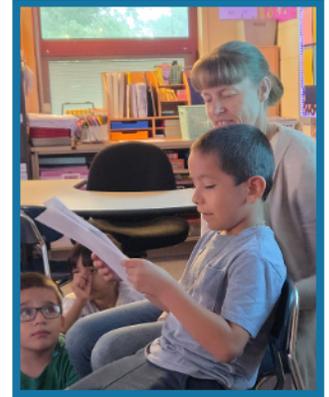
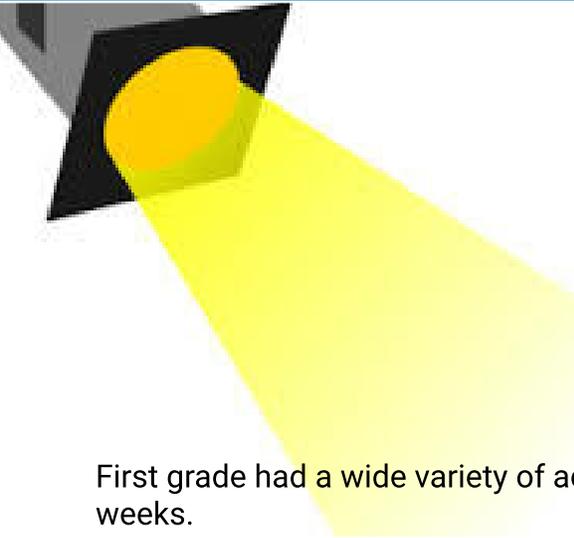
Holiday Shop
