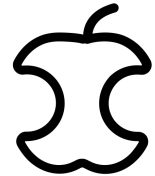
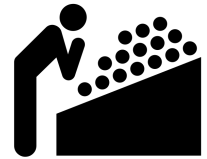
- Public Outreach Fall 2022
