Counselor News - Gifted and Talented Program Identification Notice to Parents of NEW and CURRENT Students in CFISD



Cypress-Fairbanks ISD provides Mid-year screening for students in grades 1 – 11 to receive gifted and talented services through the HORIZONS program if they are enrolled at a CFISD campus and whose referral is received by **November 21, 2025**.




