

IB@GB Admissions Policy

According to the IB Mission Statement, “the International Baccalaureate aims to develop inquiring, knowledgeable and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect.”

Students who enroll in IB courses at GBHS should be inspired by that mission statement.

In addition, students who would like to enroll in IB classes must meet the prerequisites listed for each course in the GBHS Course Catalog. (The GBHS Course Catalog is posted on the GBHS website [here](#).)

They and their parents/guardians must also electronically acknowledge the [GBHS Honor Code](#) and the [GBHS Memo of Understanding](#) when they register for an IB course. That Google Form will be posted in the Course Catalog and emailed to students and their parents.

If students and parents/guardians do not sign and turn in those documents, the students may not be enrolled in any IB course.

This IB@GB Admission Policy will be annually reviewed by the IB PLT each fall, and it will be posted under IB@GB Policies on the IB Programme website for Granite Bay High School. (As of Feb 4, 2025, that link is [here](#) on our IB@GB website.)
