Sport Scholarship candidates are expected to demonstrate exceptional talent or potential through at least one sport in which they would make a significant contribution to School life. This is not an 'all-rounder' award but an award for excellence in a specific sport. Candidates are normally of county/academy standard, although awards may be based on potential to reach this standard. Please note that scholarships may **only cover 5% of the School fee**.

We offer scholarships in the disciplines listed below. Boys will only be assessed in **one sport**. Please send a portfolio of suitable evidence to sportscholarships@harrowschool.org.uk.

The subject of the email should include **your son's full name, date of birth and his chosen sport**.

Evidence should consist of:

- sports references from any clubs and supporting documents from relevant coaches
- a sports CV consisting of rankings or scores and any other sporting achievements
- your son's most recent academic school report

If applicable, please send a maximum of two videos, but this is not necessary.

The deadline for receipt of the email is **5pm on 30 September 2026**.
