Distance Learning Days will be called when conditions prohibit students from safely getting to or being in school buildings, yet allow for students to access learning activities digitally via Internet resources. Conditions include but are not limited to, inclement weather, emergency operations, facilities issues, etc.

To the best of our ability Distance Learning Days will be anticipated in advance so that students bring their one to one devices home in preparation of these events.

Distance Learning Days By Level	
Preschool and Pre-K	Families will receive all activities and materials, accompanied by directions and/or an outline of work, sent home in student's backpacks or through email prior to the Distance Learning Day. Teachers will be available by email to answer any questions families have during their scheduled class time on the Distance Learning Day. All special education services will be scheduled and families will be notified via email of their child's live session(s).
Half and Full day Kindergarten - Grade 5	Families will be notified via email and/or online platform of all live sessions scheduled for instruction, and attend any virtual sessions their teacher(s) assigns. Students will use Google Classroom to access all other activities and practice of lessons delivered.
Middle school Grades 6-8	Students will follow the schedule of the day as if it were an 'in-school' day. For example the day will continue to be an 'A' day or 'B' day based on the planned calendar. Students will attend classes virtually based on a 'normal' school day schedule.
High School Grades 9-12	Students will follow the schedule of the day as if it were an 'in-school' day. For example the day will continue to be an 'A' day or 'B' day based on the planned calendar. Students will attend classes virtually based on a 'normal' school day schedule.
