MEETING MINUTES



Meeting called to order at 4:39 pm by Espie Ruiz

Approval of Minutes from Previous SSC Meeting. Espie Ruiz made a motion to approve the October minutes. Stephanie Wells seconded the motion.

Uniform Complaint Procedures: No one had issues or questions with the uniform complaint procedures.

Attendance Policy: In order to ensure that processes are followed there will be a notification sent to all families.

Upcoming Parent Education Opportunities: Alex Jauregui asked Elide Herrera for what types of educational opportunities parents/guardians would be interested in attending.
