Submission Guidelines

- Artwork must be **original** and created by the student.
- Submit on **8.5” x 11” paper** or digitally (high-resolution JPEG or PDF).
- Use bold colors and strong outlines to ensure the design enlarges well.
- One entry per student.
- Include **name, age, school, and contact information** with your submission.



Selection & Display

- Selected artwork will be **professionally adapted** and displayed on the District’s water tank.
- A commemorative plaque will recognize the student artists.
- All entries will be highlighted in an **online gallery** at waterdistrict10.org.
