Curriculum

- Innovamat Education - quote
 - Innovamat is an educational company that develops a research-based math curriculum. We will implement this for our Tier 3 interventions. These students have significant conceptual gaps. This curriculum uses manipulative materials, dynamic lessons, and a digital platform to foster problem-solving, critical thinking, and communication skills. The program is designed to be adaptive and includes resources for teachers, students, and families. The monies will be used to purchase student materials and complete teacher training.
