# Highlights



## Renaissance Star Assessments

- 100% of learners in 2nd-7th grade were assessed in window 1
- Early Literacy proficiency increased by 3% from fall 24 to fall 25
- Reading proficiency is within 1-3% in grades 2-7 from fall 24 to fall 25.



## Highlights

- 93% of learners in 8th graders were assessed in window 1
- 8th graders have assessed 10% higher than in the fall of 2024 as 7th graders

- Increased academic differentiation
